

Insurance criminals are ripping off the insurance industry and the American public every day. We all pay the price for their crimes. By working together, we can help arrest fraud and arson.

Award Criteria

- Grinnell Mutual Reinsurance Company will award up to \$10,000 to any person providing credible evidence leading to the identification of arsonists or those who commit fraud.
- The property in question must be insured by GMRC or an affiliated farm mutual at the time of loss.
- The award may be made if the information supplied is truthful, credible and of material assistance in identifying the arsonist or person committing fraud.
- Only one award shall be paid in connection with a single occurrence — regardless of the number of persons involved in committing the crime or providing information.
- An award will not be paid to any person employed by GMRC or an affiliated mutual or to any person whose duty it is to enforce the law of a city, county, state or federal government.
- An award will not be paid if any law enforcement officer or GMRC already has the information at the time it is furnished.
- A committee established by Grinnell Mutual shall be the sole judge of whether the information provided qualifies for a monetary award.

Fraud facts

Insurance fraud is an \$80 billion crime wave in the United States, according to the Coalition Against Insurance Fraud. It drives up everyone's insurance prices and costs everyone money.

- Contact your state fraud bureau.
- If you suspect fraud, contact the insurance company that is the target of fraud.
- For scams on Medicaid, Medicare and Social Security, contact the federal government.

Arson facts

Arson accounts for as many as 25% of all fires in the United States. Structure arson fires cost \$8 billion in property losses annually and kill over 300 people each year. Vehicle fires add an additional \$134 billion in losses a year.

How to help prevent arson

- Light building exteriors and entrances
- Use properly installed deadbolt locks on exterior doors
- If you notice suspicious activity, notify the police immediately.
- Board up vacant or abandoned buildings.
